It is our goal to help every person we work with to develop the skills they need to lead a happy and healthy life.





# Gibault Children's Services Charitable Gift Annuity

## What is a Charitable Gift Annuity?

A Charitable Gift Annuity is an agreement between you and Gibault in which you make an irrevocable gift of cash or securities, and in exchange, you and/or another person receive fixed lifetime payments.

In addition to receiving payments, you could receive a charitable income tax deduction in the year of the gift, and a portion of the payments received is generally tax free for many years.

There is also favorable capital gains treatment if you fund the gift with appreciated securities.

## Example of Annuity

A friend of Gibault, age 65, makes a gift to our program of \$10,000.

This would provide our friend with a return of 5.1% (\$510) annually for the rest of their life.

## What are the requirements?

Gibault requires donors to be at least age 55 and we ask gifts be a minimum of \$5,000.

## How do I establish a Charitable Gift Annuity?

Establishing an Annuity is easy! Call Patty Stiegelbauer at Gibault to receive an application and a personal summary of benefits. The benefits will be based on your age, the amount of the gift you desire to make and whether the benefits are for one or two people.

The application is a simple form you complete that provides us with the basic information Gibault needs to complete your annuity.

Gibault will ensure you know all about your benefits before you make your contribution.

## How do I receive my payment?

You can receive your payments by check quarterly, biannually or annually. Gibault can mail you your check or have it directly deposited into your account.
